## 7<sup>TH</sup> GRADE ANIMAL REPORT PRESENTATIONS

Each student will be presenting the animal they have selected to the class. The presentation is worth a total of **75 points**. 50 points will be from the content of the slides and 25 points will be for the speaking part of the presentation.

## THINGS THAT NEED TO BE TALKED ABOUT IN YOUR PRESENTATION-

- 1. The common and scientific name
- 2. Where your animal lives in the world (make sure to show the world)
- 3. Why your animal lives where it lives (what needs are provided for by where it lives)
- 4. The shelter your animal uses or stays in
- 5. What is its diet and if it changes throughout the year, make sure you explain
- 6. Where does your animal fit into the food web?
- 7. The taxonomy or classification of your animal (Kingdom, Phylum, etc.)
- 8. Is it an invertebrate or a vertebrate?
- 9. How reproduction occurs in your animal.
- 10. How many offspring are produce and how often
- 11. What are the survival rates of the young?
- 12. Who raises the young, what are they fed
- 13. Unique characteristics of your animal
- 14. Super cool things that haven't already been mentioned.
- \*\*\*Make sure you cite the places you find your pictures from!!!

## SUCCESTIONS...

- 1. FIRST put together a script of what you will be saying in your presentation
- 2. Put together a picture show that will follow what you are saying in the presentation. You will want to make sure the pictures match up with your speaking, you wouldn't want to be talking about diet and there are pictures of your animal's home on the screen.
- 3. Record your speaking and then double check to make sure the pictures match the speaking
- 4. MAKE SURE THE SPEAKING IS CLEAR AND HEARABLE!!
