	<p>Grading: Everything in class is graded on points. If you divide how many points you have earned by how many points were possible, that will tell you the percent you have in the class or on an assignment. Grades are posted, regularly on Skyward so students can check their progress. You will need to know your student I.D. number and password to check your grade on the computer. If you have trouble accessing your grade online, you will need to contact the office.</p>
	<p>Homework: The purpose of homework is to reinforce what students learned in class. Homework will not be an everyday experience. Most homework will be to complete something that was started in class or to practice and review the current topics in class. All assignments are due at the start of the class period, unless otherwise stated. Students are encouraged to have their work finished so it can be graded on time.</p>
	<p>Review, Complete, and Correct the INB: Students work at different rates, and although the majority of INB assignments will be completed in class, not every child will finish within the allotted time. This assignment provides “catch-up” time for those who need it and “review” time for those whose INBs are complete and correct.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Re-read your notes for the section we are working on in class. 2. If you did not finish an assignment in class, complete it at home. Refer to your instructions as necessary. 3. If there is an assignment from the previous week that is missing, please use this time to complete or correct it. <p>INB CHECKS WILL TAKE PLACE RANDOMLY, MAKE SURE IT IS UP TO DATE AT ALL TIMES TO ACHIEVE MAXIMUM POTENTIAL.</p>
	<p>Missing/Late/Absent work: All work can be completed and turned in at any time up until 2 weeks before the end of the semester. It is the student’s responsibility to get the work from the website should they chose to not do it when it is handed out to them. Students may re-do work that is not 100% if they choose, the work must be stapled to the original with a parent/guardian signature on it. Tests & quizzes can be retaken as well with parent signature on the original and a time arranged with the teacher.</p>
