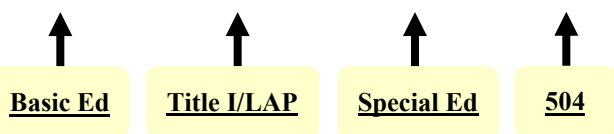

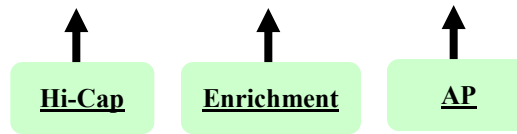
RTI: System of Interventions

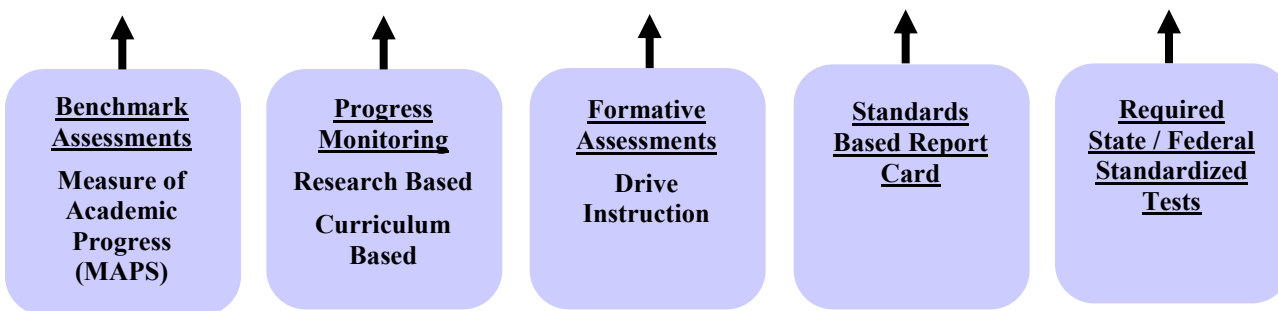
Challenge

2nd Floor: How do we know that students have learned it?

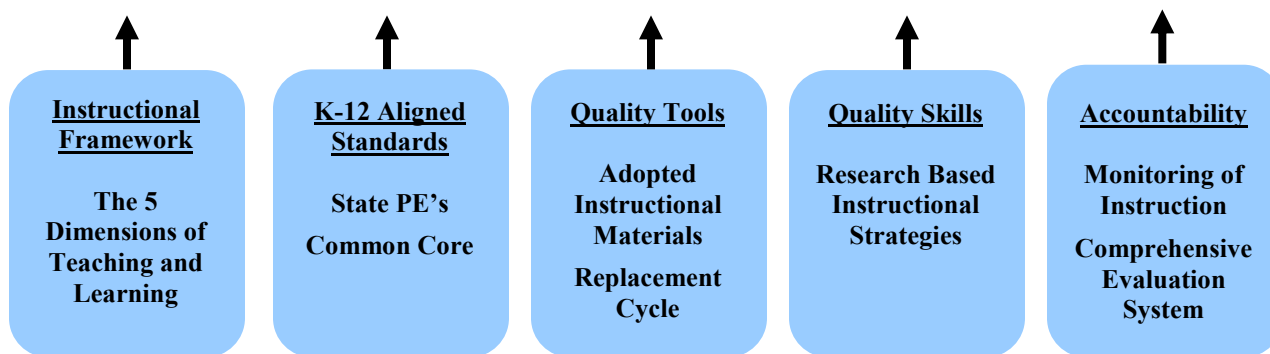
District Assessment / Data Program
