

Purpose of the award program.

The purpose of the Rainier School District's Graduate of Distinction Program is to provide an avenue for recognizing high school graduates of Rainier High School who have distinguished themselves in their communities, professions or careers and to honor the Rainier School District's staff members who were the most inspirational in the lives of those individuals.

Who may nominate?

Anyone interested in the Rainier School District.

Eligibility for nomination

- 1. Must have graduated from high school in the Rainier School District at least 5 years prior to nomination.
- 2. Need not be a current resident of Rainier.
- 3. Need not be present to accept the award, but will make a concerted effort to be present or send a representative to accept the award.

Selection criteria

Recognition is intended to honor Rainier High School graduates for outstanding achievement. The honor will be given to mature adults who are exemplary citizens and have distinguished themselves in their communities, their professions or their careers. This may include service to humanity, exceptional career achievement or accomplishments in many areas. No committee member shall make a nomination. Selection shall be made by the entire committee, and the process is intended to be absolutely confidential. Up to five awards may be granted each year. Nominations will be held for five year years and will automatically be included in the selection process during that time.

Composition of the selection committee.

The committee shall consist of seven (7) voting members.

- 1. One (1) member of the committee will be a Board of Education member, one (1) member will be the high school principal and one (1) member will be the district superintendent.
- 2. General committee membership will include four (4) individuals from the general public who are residents of the Rainier School District, but are not school district employees. The Rainier High School Principal and Superintendent will serve as co-chairs.
