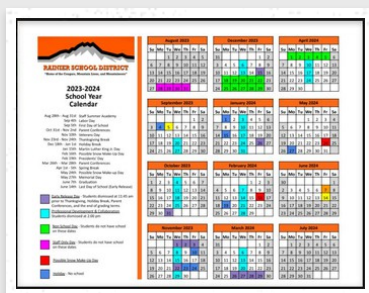

Your child's daily, on-time attendance is critical to their success in school. When your child is not in class, they are missing out on critical learning. This puts them at risk of falling behind and not graduating from high school. Even as little as two absences in a month, whether they are excused or unexcused, can make a big difference, from kindergarten through their senior year.*

At 9:00 AM, the attendance secretary, Debbie Ortmyer, starts calling the parents of unexcused absent students. If you know your child will be absent, please call the school as soon as possible: 360-446-4020. Attendance can also be entered through Skyward Family Access if entered before 9:00 AM.
